Confused on what you need to do for transitioning from Salesperson to Broker OR Broker to Managing Broker?

General Information

- Proficiency Review Courses will be available at PAAR starting in January. The Registration Form is available at www.paarealtors.com and will also be mailed to you.
- At the local Association you will be able to receive 3 HRS. CE CREDIT for taking the Proficiency Review Class.
- Although CE can be taken before or after Proficiency Exam, we recommend you take it before to be better prepared.
- Salespeople have to renew by April 30, 2012, and have until April 30, 2012 to take CE, **not April 30, 2011.**
- For those of you interested in the Transition Course rather than the Proficiency Exam; the Transition Course is being developed by Illinois Association of Realtors® and is under review with IDFPR. When the course material is released to the Association we will provide you with all the information.

Salespeople

Two Options to Transition:

Proficiency Exam Route

- Pass Proficiency Exam.
- CE Requirements are 9 hrs CORE & 9 hrs Elective (you can apply the Proficiency Review course for 3 hr CE credit.)
- Pass Proficiency Exam to receive your Broker's License
- Renew your license before April 30, 2012

Transition Course

- Pass 30 hr course, no CE will then be required.
- There is NO state test, just pass the class exam.

Managing Brokers

Two Options to Transition:

Proficiency Exam Route

- Pass Proficiency Exam.
- 18 hours of CE under proposed rule change - expiring on April 30, 2013
- CE Requirements are 9 hrs CORE & 9 hrs Elective (you can apply Proficiency Review course for 3 hr CE credit.)
- Take 12 hrs of LIVE Broker Management Class
- Pass Proficiency Exam to receive your Managing Broker's License.
- Renew your license before April 30, 2013

Transition Course

- Take 45 hr course, no CE will then be required.
- There is NO state test, just pass the class exam.
